- I. Meeting was called to order by President Bob Duke.

- II. President Duke called on the parliamentarian Myra Myers to conduct the business portion of the General Membership Meeting.

Mrs. Myers reviewed with the membership that the meetings will be conducted under the Bylaws of the Association and Roberts Rules of Order 10th Edition.

Mrs. Myers presented the first motion to the general assembly.

I move that the following item be added to the ABGA sanction rules under the paragraph "Eligibility of Animals"

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to determine the eligibility of the animals. An animal is not eligible to be shown to a judge if, judge or the judge's family, sold the goat, if the judge or the judge's family were the breeder or if the judge or the judge's family owns the sire or dam. A breach of this rule will result in a fine of \$25 and the exhibitor will be prohibited from showing at an ABGA sanctioned show for 90 days. If the exhibitor repeats the offense, fine will be \$50 and be prohibited from showing at an ABGA sanctioned show for 180 days. If an animal is shown that is not eligible and is awarded points or awards, the points and/or awards will be removed from said animal.

Vote on amendment: To change the second sentence to read if the judge or the judge's family were the previous owner, once removed.
