Entry forms: Please use a different form for each type of show. ABGA and JABGA please list on two separate forms. If the ABGA animal is registered under a different name, please note that out to the left side. No substitutions after 8:00 AM Saturday; scratches only. Please be sure to note a legible email address for updates. Mark entry form if you want electric hook-up for camping, a camper hook up is a separate cost, but available.

Arrival and Check-in: Please do not arrive before 12 pm Friday, November 3rd at 12:00 noon.

Pens: Pens are listed but not included in the entry price. Pen size is 10 x 10. Pens will be designated when you arrive. Be sure to mark on form if you want to pen near someone. Pens are set up for Friday at 12 o'clock at check in.

Shavings: Shavings are offered for \$3.00 per pen. Please enclose money with entry forms. Additional quantities will not be available.

Registrations: ALL ANIMALS MUST BE ABGA REGISTERED TO BE SHOWN IN ABGA and JABGA SHOW. Original registration papers are required to check in, except as noted in ABGA rules. Tattoos must be a <u>complete</u> match to registration papers. Tattoos will be checked on first and second place winners at the conclusion of each class. JABGA animals must be registered in member's name only. No family name. JABGA must verify with membership cards.

Concessions: We will have concessions prepared to serve 10:00 - 4:00 Saturday and lunch Sunday will be on grounds.

Health Requirements: We will be checking animals.. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases will be allowed (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, etc.). All animals outside SC must have current interstate health papers within 30. Any questionable issues will be decided by Show committee and their decision is final.

Miscellaneous: Exhibitors are responsible for safety and care of their goats. No animals are allowed to run free on the grounds; dogs must be leashed. No Smoking within 20 feet of the barns or show arena. NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON GROUNDS.

Sportsmanship: Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately, and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show. This is a family atmosphere.

JABGA Additional rules: Please be sure to read the Buckle Series sanctioned show rules. Please remember to have the letter from ABGA for showing sibling's goats or you will not be allowed to do so. Please be sure to have your 2017 JABGA membership card to show at check-in.

Showmanship: Showmanship classes are as follows: PeeWee Division (6 years and younger)
Junior Division (7-9 years of age)
Intermediate Division (10-14 years of age)
Senior Division (15-18 years of age)

At the end of the day, please remember the JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL, however in case of a discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, show committee decision will be final.
