

Stick-of-Shame

Horned goats always seem to think the grass is greener on the other side, no matter which side of the fence they are standing on. As a result you will find them with their head stuck in the fence.

Some goat owners resort to drastic measures to stop the head in the fence goat trick. They attach a water hose, PVC pipe, or a stick to the horns with duct tape or clamps. To prevent this, I attach a piece of PVC pipe across their horns, close to the horn base, and secure it with duct tape wrapped in a figure 8. In the goat world, this is known as the Stick-of-Shame.
